

Higher Education Scholarship Guidelines

1. The Mid Atlantic Dwarf Hotot Club (MADHC) will award one education scholarship in an amount to be determined annually.
2. The scholarship money shall be maintained by the MADHC Treasurer and come from the general funds unless other money becomes available.
3. Applicants will be interviewed by a member of MADHC on Saturday during the PaSRBA Convention in February. In the event the applicant is unable to attend the PaSRBA Convention, a telephone interview will be conducted.
4. The Scholarship Committee will score the applications. The MADHC Board of Directors must approve. The applicant with the highest score will receive the award.
5. The results of the scores of the application and the interview will be totaled and submitted to the MADHC President no later than 5:00 pm on the Saturday during the PaSRBA Convention.
6. The MADHC President will vote in the case of a tie.
7. The winner will be announced at the MADHC membership meeting held during the PaSRBA Convention in February.

Requirements for Receiving a Scholarship

1. Applications must be submitted on the scholarship form obtained from the MADHC website or from the Higher Education Scholarship Committee chairman. Computer forms must be in the original format.
2. The recipient must be at least in their 3rd consecutive year of MADHC membership.
3. Applicant may apply for the scholarship during their senior year of high school or home school through junior year of college.
4. Scholarship proceeds may be used to further education at a University, College or Trade School where a diploma, certificate or license will be issued upon completion of the program of study.
5. Scholarship will be paid upon receipt of confirmation of University, College or Trade School enrollment.
6. Applications must be mailed by US Mail or electronically to the Chairman of the Higher Education Scholarship Committee by July 1st of the application year.
7. Applicant is eligible to win only one scholarship.
